


Time as an instructional variable

 Educational psychologist and researcher Benjamin Bloom concluded:

We are expressing the view that, given sufficient time and appropriate types of help, 95% of students ... can learn a subject up to a high level of mastery. We are convinced that the grade of 'A' as an index of mastery of a subject can, under appropriate conditions, be achieved by up to 95% of the students in a class. (p. 4).

Think about them as....

Personalization

 As the overall system goal as compared to a factory model

Competency Education

 A structural foundation designed to ensure students are learning and progressing



Personalized Learning

 Meeting each students' needs, with voice and choice in how, what, where, and when they learn based on interests; an approach to ensure students are engaged and getting the instructional opportunities and supports they need to be successful

Blended Learning

 An instructional delivery system -- using both online and face-to-face instruction -- as a powerful delivery system that can be used to enable competency education and personalized learning



One of MLA's tools: Personalized Extended Learning Opportunity (PELO)

Primary acquisition of knowledge and skills through instruction or study outside of the traditional classroom methodology

- •Linked to Iowa Core standards, usually in multiple domains
- •Guided, quasi-independent study through private instruction, performing groups, internships, apprenticeships, non-traditional courses, online courses
- •Students demonstrate new knowledge, skills, or competencies
- •Stretches student creativity and leverages outside resources/expertise
- •Linkages to career pathways and student interests
- •Time, hours, mode, and method are flexible (weekends, school break times, evenings, summers, are all in play.)
